After a short introduction and a logo ice breaker, the morning continued with networking sessions with companies including HSBC, Bank of America, King's College Hospital NHS Trust, Direct Line Group, Matrix and Microsoft, as well as presentations on 'Employers Expectations' (by Department for Work and Pensions) and 'Apprenticeships' (by British Telecom).
