# Personal Development Days - 19th and 20th July

It seems that this year we have been affected by circumstances beyond our control with our usual range of trips and visits at the end of term. With the Shard cancelling our 3 separate visits, Bewl and Bedgebury cancelling and the RMT train strikes putting paid to a whole day of London trips for years 7, 8 & 9 it seems that we haven't had the best of luck this year. Many staff have gone above and beyond to organise events at the last minute. When we plan trips and visits, there is a lot of work put in to make sure everything is risk assessed, logistically planned and resourced. We have had to put on a greater range of in-school activities this year.

By the end of next week, students in years 7-9 will have an individualised timetable of events, either in school or through trips or local experiences. There are exploratory walks to high Elms and Chartwell that need to be booked (but are free) on ParentPay.

Students do not need to be in uniform on 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> July. We do recommend that they wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the events that they are taking part in. 
