

Safer Internet Day 2023

<u>Digital Wellbeing: Safer Internet Day 2023</u> Tuesday 7th February 2023

The theme of this year's Safer Internet Day is "Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online." Engaging students in conversations about the online world is vital. By giving children the confidence and language to discuss their behaviours and habits online, we can better help them understand how to safely navigate different platforms.

We have been focussing in our Key Stage 3 classes (years 7-9) this week and next week to encourage our students to have an open discussion about the online world in our Computer Science lessons. We would like to invite you to continue having these conversations at home with your child. Most parents frequently chat with their child about how things are going at school or what's happening in their friendship groups – but those discussions often don't extend to youngsters' online activities. In fact, National Online Safety conducted a recent survey which found that only slightly more than half (54%) of parents regularly talk to their children about staying safe online.

It can be an awkward topic to broach and, of course, it needs not to feel intrusive. However, just checking in with your child about their digital life can get them thinking about online safety and alert you to any issues they might be having. In support of Safer Internet Day 2023, the attached digital guide has some useful tips on potential ways to start those conversations.

In the guide you'll find a number of useful tips such as being as honest as possible, discussing how misleading the online world can be and creating a 'family agreement'.


