Year 9 Drama perform to Parents and Staff

On Monday 6th June, Year 9 Healthy Relationships Ambassadors performed their piece 'Don't confuse love with abuse' to an audience of parents and staff.

The piece brought together three interlinking stories, two of which explored current abusive relationships and one which focused on an abuse survivor and how they successfully navigated leaving. The performance used voiceovers and audio tracks created in the Recording Studio at the school, which were played over the top of live acting so there was lots for the audience to watch, listen to and consider.

Important issues like controlling/cohesive behaviour, emotional manipulation and financial abuse were raised as well as the reasons someone might find it difficult to leave a relationship.

The students involved in this project have worked really hard over the last term to get this performance together and should be really proud of their achievements, particularly as they had not performed in front of an outside audience before. A big well done to the following students:
