Level 2 courses

Course	Minimum Requirement
GCSE Maths re-take	Grade 3 at GCSE
GCSE English re-take	Grade 3 at GCSE
Higher Sports Leadership Award (HSLA)	Meet Sixth Form entry requirements for a suitable programme of study and take Sports Studies.

Level 3 courses - the general expectation for all courses is that you have at least 5, 9 - 4 grades or equivalent at Level 2 to qualify to study in the first instance. All courses unless specified are intended as 2-year courses.

Art & Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Art
Biology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 6s two 2 GCSE separate Sciences or GCSE Combined Science - Grade 6 has to be in the relevant component in Combined Science or chosen subject in separate science ◆ Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Maths
Business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Maths ◆ Ideally the applicant will have studied Business at GCSE
Chemistry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 6 in two GCSE separate Sciences or GCSE Combined Science - Grade 6 has to be in the relevant component in Combined Science or chosen subject in separate Science ◆ Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Maths
Computer Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Computer Science ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Maths
Dance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in either English Language or English Literature ◆ Some experience of performance in Dance essential. Dancers may have to undergo an audition upon application
Design & Technology: Product Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Design Technology ◆ Grade 5 in English Language or Literature ◆ Grade 5 in Maths ◆ You will need to draw, make and have good critical analysis skills. The ability to learn and revise the wide range of subject knowledge for both exams is essential
Digital Media	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 4 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature
Drama and Theatre Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Drama ◆ Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature ◆ Applicants may have to undergo an audition
English Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or English Literature
English Literature	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or English Literature
Film Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 4 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature
Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Geography ◆ Grade 5 in either English Language or English Literature

Health and Social Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 4 in GCSE Maths ◆ Grade 4 in a GCSE Science
History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE History ◆ Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature
Information Technology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 4 in either English Language or English Literature ◆ You do not need to have studied an IT qualification at GCSE although this will be beneficial
Mathematics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 7 in GCSE Maths
Core Maths (equivalent to AS)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 4 in GCSE Maths. <i>One Year Course</i>
Medical Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 4-4 in GCSE Double Award Science ◆ Grade 4 in GCSE English Language or English Literature ◆ Grade 4 in GCSE Maths
MFL: French or German	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 6 at GCSE in the relevant language
Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Music ◆ Grade 5 standard on instrument or voice ◆ Applicants should consider taking instrumental/vocal lessons to support their studies on this course
Music Technology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Music or BTEC Music Level 2 Merit
Photography	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 4 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature is preferred ◆ GCSE Art is useful but not essential ◆ You will need a working digital camera or access to a mobile phone with a camera
Physical Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE PE ◆ Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature ◆ Grade 5 in Combined Science or Grade 5 in Biology ◆ Practical - Students must participate in one competitive sport on a weekly basis outside of school. <p>If a student did not study GCSE PE, then competitive footage must be provided of chosen sport for Head of PE to review before starting course.</p>
Physics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 6s in two GCSE separate Sciences or GCSE Combined Science - Grade 6 has to be in the relevant component in Combined Science or chosen subject in separate science ◆ Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Maths
Politics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature
Psychology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Maths ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE Science ◆ Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or English Literature
Sociology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature
Sport BTEC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 4 in GCSE PE or Merit in Level 2 BTEC ◆ Grade 4 in English Language or Literature ◆ Grade 4 in Combined Science or Grade 4 in Biology <p><i>Physiology and anatomy are one of two external exams in BTEC</i></p>
Textiles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Grade 4 in an Art and Design based course
