## KS3 Exam reminder

#### KS3 exams after half term:

Year 7 and 8 exams - Monday 3 June to Friday 14 June Year 9 exams – Monday 10 June to Friday 21 June

These assessments will take a variety of forms depending on the subject. Children have had it explained to them in the last few weeks leading up to half term how best to prepare for these exams. Techniques on how best to revise were covered during tutorial time in school and further support was given during assemblies leading up to the exam period.

In the last two weeks class teachers were telling their classes when their class exams will be so that this should be recorded in the blank timetable in their planners (page 98 and 99). This will allow organisation of revision before the relevant exam.
